Benefits

- Ability to leverage resources with the University of Nebraska at Omaha.
- Decreased the number of housing violations where Scan surveys have been conducted.
- Property owners receive notices and are given an opportunity to take care of the problem.

 - Pocket PCs assist the residents as they document and monitor their neighborhood.

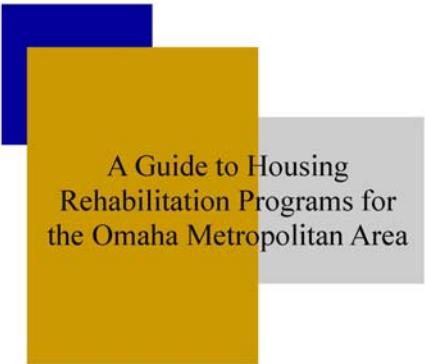


Benefits
