2. Did you read the letter?
3. Did you contact either the <<NEIGHBORHOOD ASSOCIATION>> or Omaha Neighborhood Scan to access information about your property?
4. How informative was the letter from Omaha Neighborhood Scan and <<NEIGHBORHOOD ASSOCIATION>>?
5. Have you made any repairs or addressed maintenance items on your property since receiving the scan letter?
6. What areas of your property have been repaired and/or maintained since you received the letter in <<LETTER DATE>>?
7. Was the information provided in the letter helpful to you in planning home maintenance?
8. What do you feel are the areas of your property most in need of exterior maintenance and repairs?
9. When was the last time that you undertook any home maintenance on this property?
10. A variety of factors may affect a person's ability to make routine home maintenance. Please check any of the following which have limited your ability to complete routine maintenance on your home.
11. The <<NEIGHBORHOOD ASSOCIATION>> is considering sponsoring some home maintenance workshops that offer "how-to" sessions at neighborhood properties. What would be most helpful to you? Please list areas (e.g. how to construct a safe hand railing, how to fix guttering on a home, etc.).
